
What to do if someone has diabetes Testing Supplies



Blood glucose testing supplies can be bought over-the-counter at stores like Target and Walmart, or at drug stores. If you are purchasing supplies, be sure you know the exact name of the meter as testing strips are not interchangeable between meters.

The "house brand" meters at Walmart are the Glucocard 01 or Presto. The "house brand" meter at Target is called Up & Up. All meters sell for about \$10.00 and a box of 25 strips costs about \$12.00. Be sure these meters come with a lancing pen and lancets. Testing equipment should not be shared.

Supplies needed for testing blood glucose

Blood glucose meter Strips (must be the correct strips for the meter; strips are not interchangeable) Lancing device Lancets

Access to soap and water
Alcohol wipes or alcohol and tissue / cotton if no access to soap and water

Sharps container for lancet disposal (heavy plastic bottle can be used; when full, put cap on, seal with duck tape, mark as "sharps", dispose of in trash)
