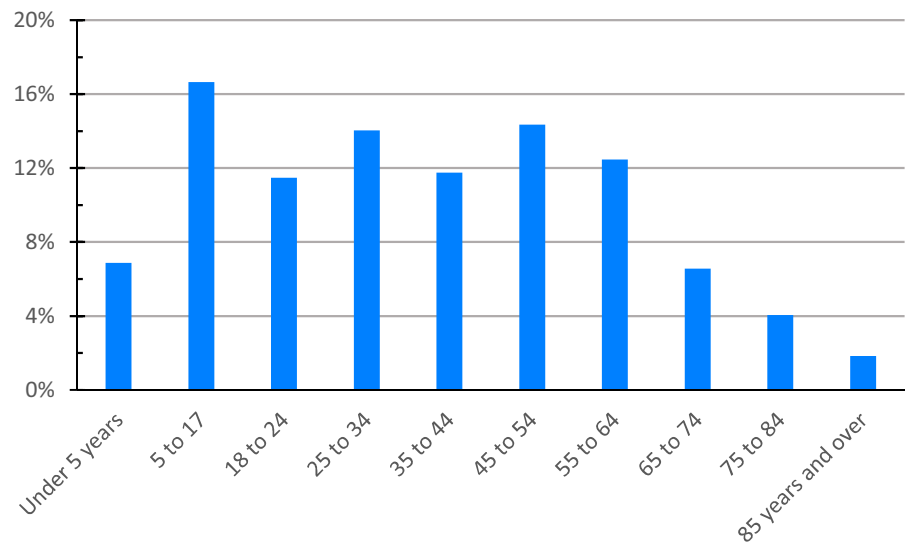

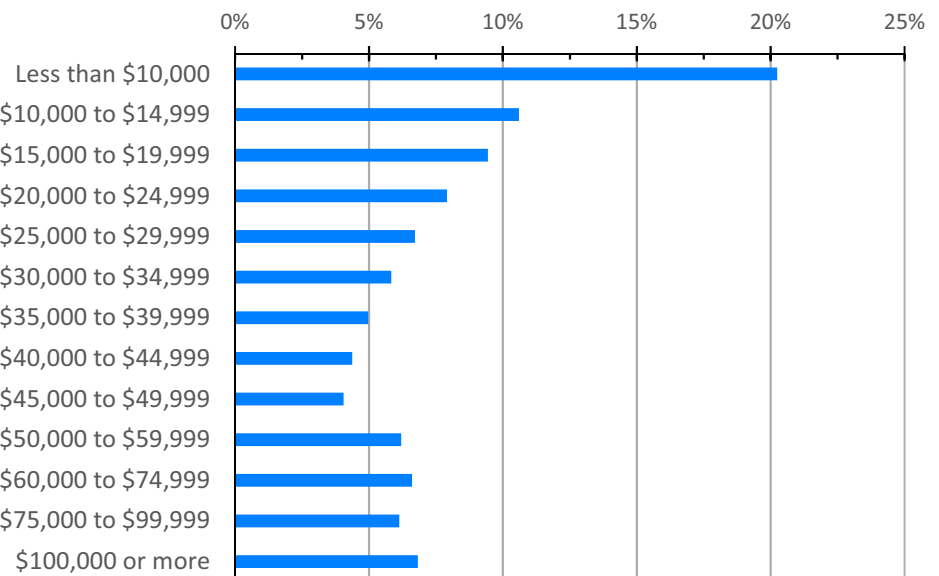

Household Income By Percent†

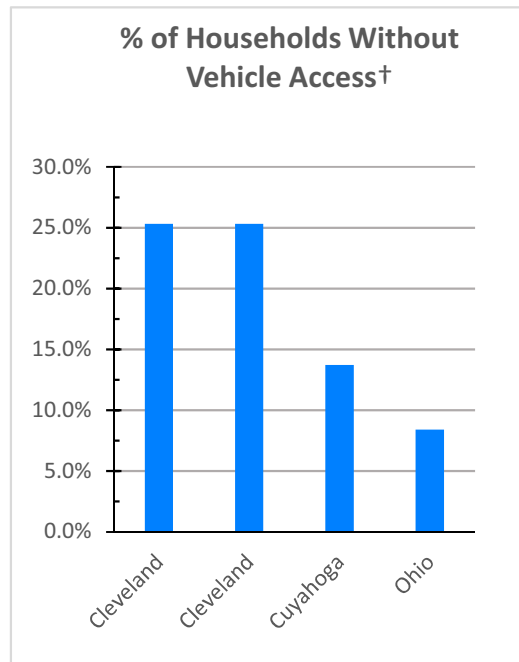

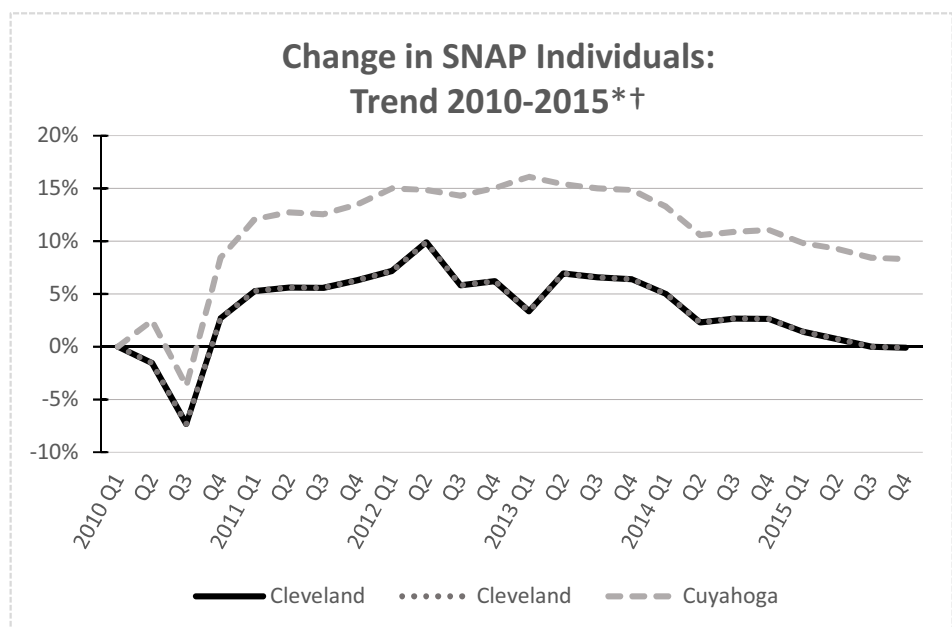
