

4 Pillars

Locally, identify projects to accomplish the each of the 4 Pillars within Cuyahoga County

Expectations

- 75% reduction in cases within 5 years
- 90% reduction in cases within 10 years

EtHE 4 Pillars



Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

Treat people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.





Prevent new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

Respond quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.

Prevention Planning Meeting

- Regional Advisory Group Integration into Planning Council
- This will occur by March 2021 Prevention grantees have been invited to PC meetings in the meanwhile
- Potentially a Prevention subcommittee
- Prevention committee members without being a full PC member

Rapid Start of ART

- 3 Medical Providers funded to start a Rapid Start of Anti- Retroviral process at their agency (CCF, Metro and UH)
- Development of a protocol
- Integration into the newly diagnosed system – reduce wait time for 1st appointments
- Get clients ART on the 1st appointment
