



## Cuyahoga County Overdose Data to Action Initiative

Drughelp.care is a free searchable website that matches persons with substance use disorder with available treatment services by allowing treatment providers to list the number of open treatment services available daily.

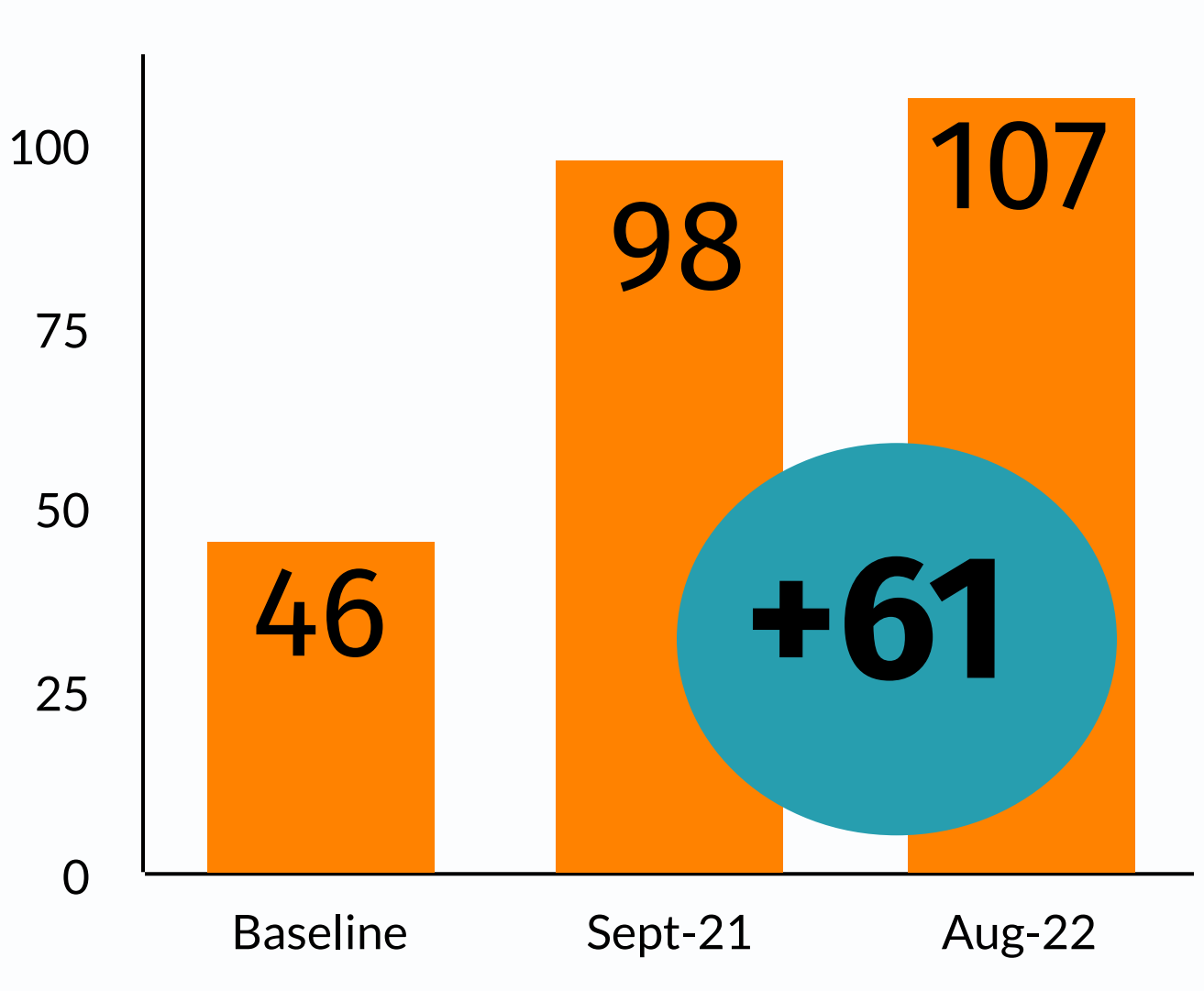
To evaluate the web-based technology's effectiveness in reaching those seeking treatment, the number of visitors to the web app, the total page views, the number of registered agencies and treatment services, and the number of agencies regularly providing on-demand information on available slots and wait time for their services.

In the past year of the grant, drughelp.care added additional types of services and increased the number of treatment providers' information on the web app.

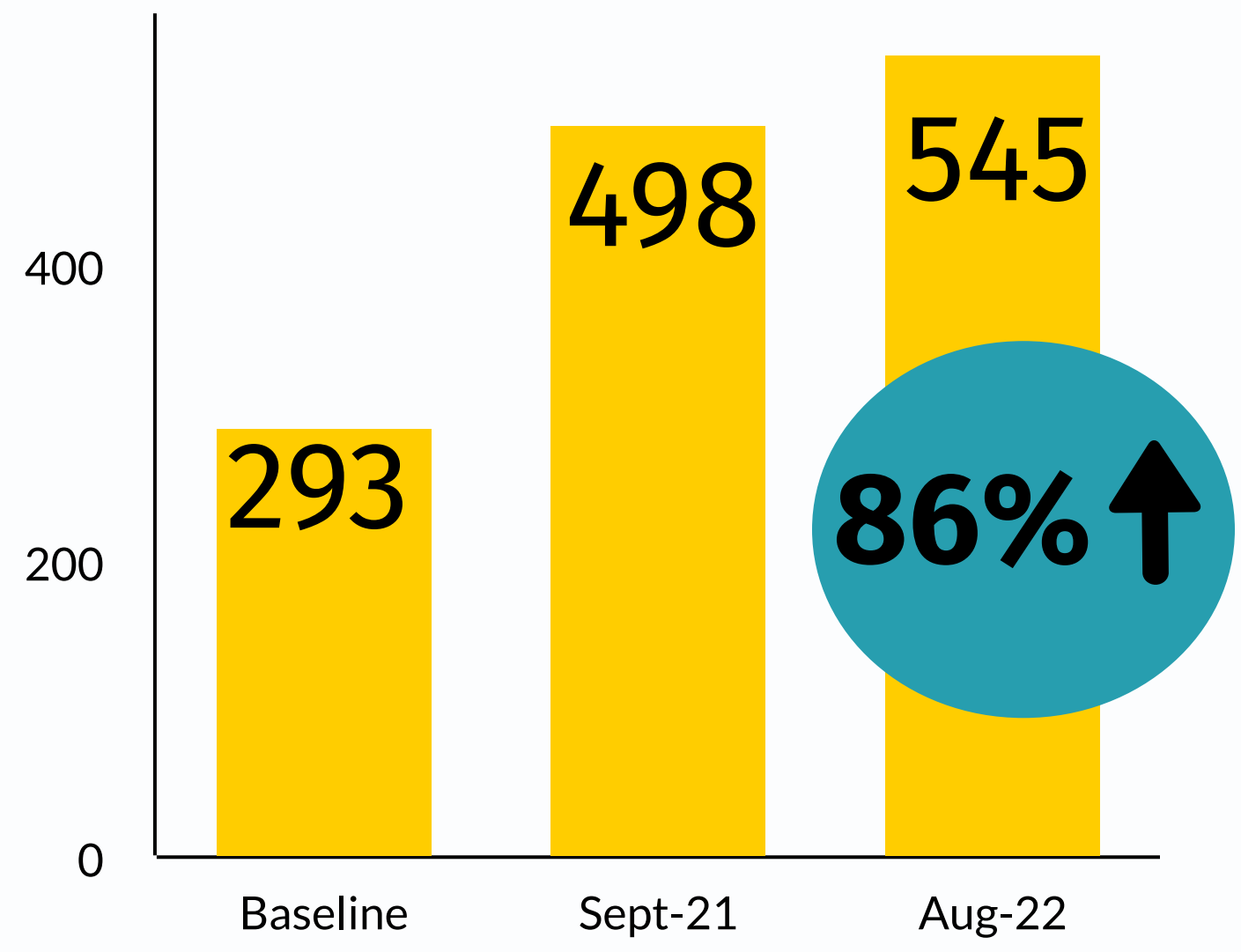
## Treatment Providers & Services



### Registered Treatment Providers

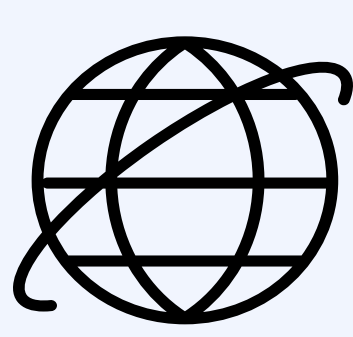


### Registered Treatment Services

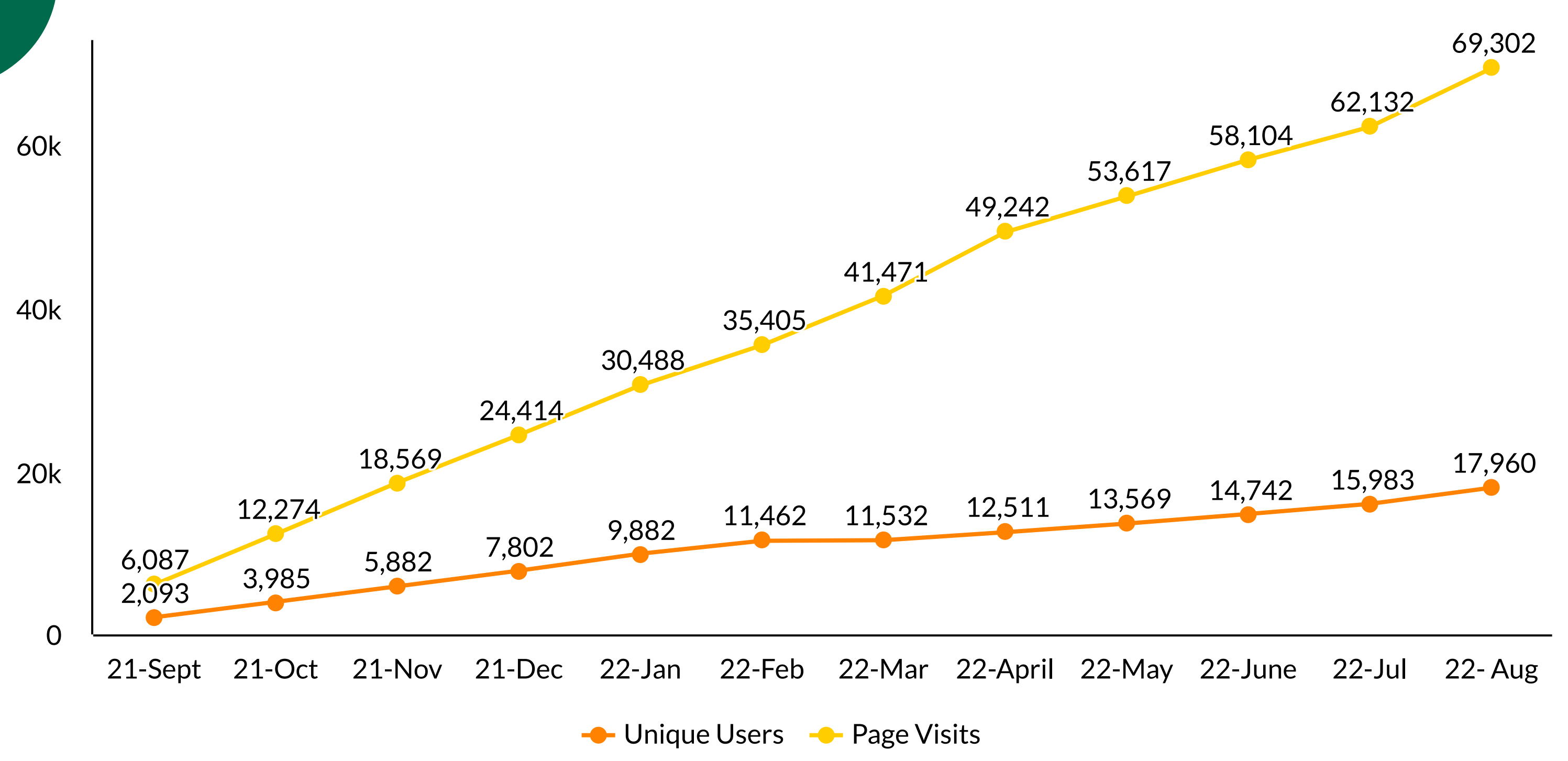
