Dear Sewage Treatment System (STS) Contractor:

Enclosed you will find an application for the 2023 STS Contractor Registrations and Septage Hauler Vehicle Permits. These registrations are effective January 1, 2023 and are valid for the 2023 calendar year. Please complete the application form with all of your pertinent information, and remember that **prior** to initiating work on an STS, it is required that that you are registered with this office.

Along with your application, you are required to submit the following or your application cannot be processed and will be returned to you:

- Certificate of passing the required Ohio Department of Health Examination
- Proof of General Liability Insurance (not less than \$500,000.00)
- Proof of Statewide Surety Bond
- Proof of qualifications to service proprietary systems and components
- A letter on company letterhead stating which systems you will be registering to service, including registering to conduct point of sale inspections
- Proof of completion of a minimum of 6 CEU hours approved by ODH in 2022
- A copy of the Septage Hauler Truck Inspection Report for each vehicle to be registered
- A copy of the Service Provider Inspection Report, if registering as a service provider\*
