PARENT SUPPORT LEAD PROGRAM AND EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES





Our no cost services are open to children age 0-5 with confirmed or suspected high lead levels and aim to reduce the impact of lead on child development and limit exposure to lead in the home. Children under 3, who are eligible, may receive these supports through Early Intervention services at Bright Beginnings.

Lead dust is on our shoes, toys, and even in the walls, doors, and windows of homes built before 1978.

#3 CHILDREN UNDER 6
ARE MOST VULNERABLE.

A 2019 study showed that 1 and 4 Cleveland kindergarteners started school careers with elevated levels of lead. Lead poisoning can lead to damage to the brain and nervous system, resulting in learning and behavior problems, hearing and speech problems, and delayed growth and development.
