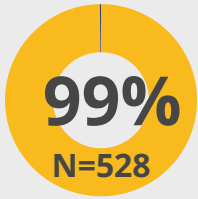


# ExAM Program

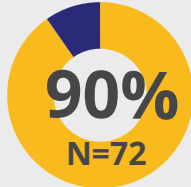
Rates of opioid use in the criminal justice system are disproportionately high relative to the general population. MetroHealth's Expanding Access to Medication Assisted Treatment (ExAM) Program provides persons incarcerated in the Cuyahoga County Corrections Center access to Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT).

### Agree to Participate

During YR 3 528 inmates at the Cuyahoga County Corrections Center were assessed and approached to participate. Only 1 individual of those approached did not participate.

### Referral to Treatment

Once released from incarceration, inmates are referred to community-based MAT services. The program is designed to refer all clients who participate while incarcerated to community treatment services upon release. 72 individuals were released from jail in YR3 and all 72 were referred.

### Linked Upon Release

Of the 72 individuals who were released from jail, 65 individuals linked with community-based MAT services.
