




# Overdose Fatality Review (OFR)

The Medical Examiner's Office, in partnership with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health and the ADAMHS Board, has reestablished Overdose Fatality Reviews. OFR cases are selected based on emerging trends in the opioid epidemic.

Recommendations identified by OFR

Increase awareness knowledge of **harm** reduction tools

Support training of medical providers on prescription medication increase number of MAT providers


