## Cuyahoga County Board of Health (CCBH) Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) Initiative

Highlights from OD2A evaluation findings for St. Vincent Charity Medical Center (SVCMC) Year One (September 2019-August 2020)

### SBIRT (Screening, Brief, Intervention and Referral Treatment)

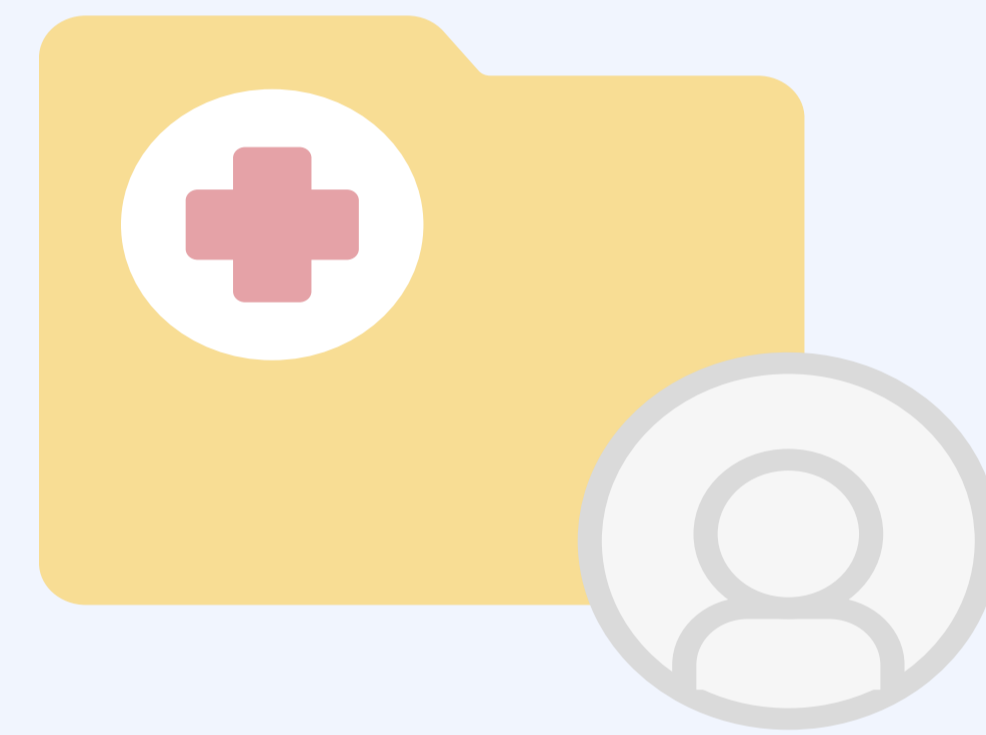
The SBIRT Program at SVCMC is an evidence-based approach to deliver early intervention treatment services for individuals with substance use disorders, or those at risk of developing a substance use disorder. This program was implemented in April 2020 in two inpatient units. From April to August, 362 patients received a primary screen. Out of these 362, 130 patients were approached for a secondary screening for substance use. This evaluation examines the SVCMC SBIRT program's ability to identify and link patients in need of treatment for addiction.

### Engagement in Program Services



#### Patients Engaged

130 patients were approached for secondary screens, and 125 agreed to participate.



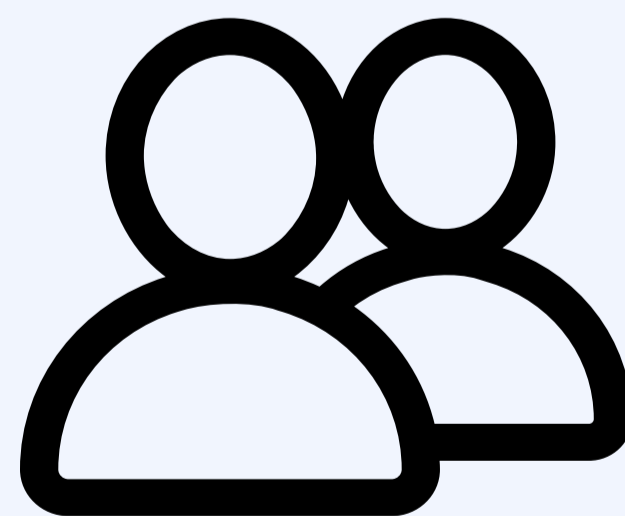
#### Patient Referral

122 patients were referred to treatment services, 63 patients of whom agreed to that referral. 76% of those who agreed to that referral were linked to treatment services.

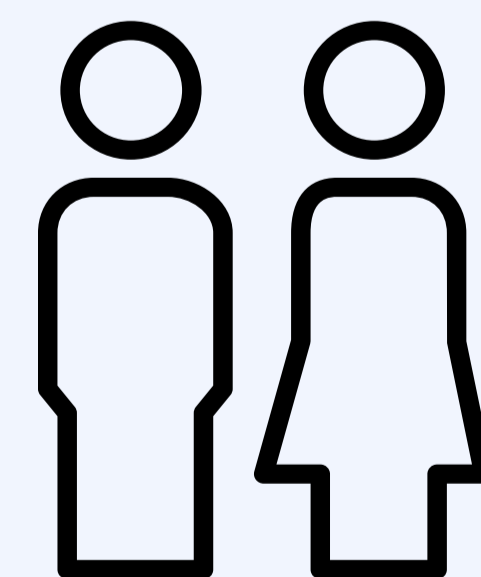
