	<p>Step 1: Snowflake</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No large group discussion. <p>Step 2: Snowflake</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No large group discussion. <p>Step 3: Avalanche</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No large group discussion. <p>Step 4: Ice Age</p> <p><u>Group #1:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overarching goal is education of youth <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Work in school as much as possible while following Ohio abstinence-only laws ○ Educating primary care and medical staff regarding having sex with HIV-positive people (U=U) ○ Increasing routine screening and the use of opt out testing – opt in testing has not worked for a long time ○ Educating medical facilities; administrative and medical staff about inclusive language and pronouns ○ Using language to make patients want to come back and continue receiving medical care <p><u>Group #2:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Education and training • Cultural competency <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Especially when asking patients questions – gender-affirming care ○ First person language and questions; non-categorization language (“risky sex”) • Testing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Ensuring that providers test for multiple STIs and not just one 	

- **Community education**
 - Funding for Programs
 - Theater groups that involve kids to talk about themselves, their bodies, etc.
 - Go from school to school to perform
 - Programs that support medication and not just the education
- **Accessibility**
 - Access for youth under the age of 18 – STI screening
 - Access to gender-affirming care
- **Navigating insurance**
 - Utilizing insurance; free testing
 - Teaching youth how to navigate parents’ insurance and how to keep things confidential
- **Online resources**
 - Comprehensive website for patients to access prevention services from all local agencies
 - Each agency throughout the region lists the services that they provide

 - Has a website with a search tool
 - Provides free Narcan trainings for people to become distributors
 - Distribute Narcan throughout the state
