Laboratory Requirements:

Lead laboratories must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Possess Ohio Department of Health approval for analysis of dust, paint chip, and soil for lead content
- Certified by the EPA's National Lead Laboratory Accreditation Program (NLLAP)
- Accredited for the analysis of lead dust wipes, paint chips, and soil under the Environmental Lead Laboratory Accreditation Program (ELLAP)
- Provide a minimum 2 hour turn-around time, in addition to 24 hour, and 5 day turnaround times as measured from the time the samples are received at the laboratory for the requested materials
- Provide electronic transmittal of results
