**Crib for Kids Mini Grant
Notes & Questions and Answers**

Questions & Answers:

Q1. 1.If an agency has an existing partnership with CCBH are we still eligible for this grant opportunity?

A1. Yes, as long as your agency meets the eligibility guidelines...501c3, target population, target zip code, and dispense required pack and plays.

Q2. If yes, would the minimum required distribution of kits (70/140) be in addition to what we are currently already doing?

A2. Yes, it would be in addition and the distribution would be separate. (we also must adhere to the fact that we do not have an unlimited number of pack n plays)

Q3. For the eligibility criteria listed on the RFP, does a recipient (mom/dad/family) need to fulfill just one of them or all/a few of them? I.e. could the kits be distributed to any mother who is 32+ weeks pregnant/have an infant less than one year of age or do they have to be that AND also below 200% of the FPL/parents who live in separate homes?

A3. The recipient would have to fulfill all eligibility requirements and live in the targeted zip code area.

Q4. Can you please confirm that the budget request would not include the cost of Safe Sleep Kits as those would be provided to grant recipients directly?

A4. The budget would include salary time to conduct these activities, gift card incentives, cost of venue rentals etc. The grant funds may not be used to purchase additional pack n plays. Safe sleep kits would be provided to the awardee/agency by CCBH. Yes, the funds awarded can be used for salary, activities, gift card incentives etc.

Q5. Can our agency use the funding for employee salaries?

A5. Yes, mini grant funds can be used to support salaries of employees provided that all eligibility requirement are met.

Q6. Can I provide services for those outside of the targeted zip code?

A6. No you must serve the target zip code 44102, 44103, 44104, 44105, 44106, 44108, 44109, 44110, 44111, 44112, 44113, 44120, 44127, 44128, 44135, and 44137

Q7. Our agency is interested in applying for the mini grant but we are not sure how to track and evaluate our Safe Sleep Kit distribution and impact on the community?

A7. Agencies may use a survey to track participants, or develop a survey tool for feedback and impact, you may also use an attendance form, pre and post surveys or spreadsheet to track distribution.
