	 Additional Meeting Discussion Points: CAG 2024 and Beyond: How soon would subcommittees start? Create subgroups within subcommittees and appoint leaders of diverse representation. Timing of meetings, transportation, internet/phone access, and competing priorities may be barriers to client involvement in subcommittees. Coming to the clients' spaces and holding meeting in non-traditional hours/locations would be ideal. There seems to be a lack of urgency for subcommittee meetings. Check-ins, zoom options, and clear objectives would be important considerations for subcommittees to stay accountable and on track. One task of subcommittees could be to revise the jurisdictional to make goals and objectives more measurable. Hold subcommittee meetings monthly/bi-monthly to increase productivity. Large group meetings would need to be intentional to ensure they are interactive and not redundant. Multiple partners offered to provide space for committee meetings to better meet stakeholders and clients where they are. Additional Meeting Discussion Points: Professional Development Trainings Needs Assessment: Discussions focusing on local issues rather than national; and further, lead trainers who are knowledgeable about local issues. Additional potential topics: know your rights; resume building for clients; continuing education; one data entry point for client-level data.
