 - B. Contracts, MOU's, agreements with no exchange of funds (IRB's, BAA's, Addendums, etc.):
 - 1. CRC 2024-057 Environmental Public Health Services submitting a Local Administrator Agreement with the Ohio Department of Health, Healthy Housing and Lead Poisoning Surveillance System (HHLPSS) to provide access to the HHLPSS for the purpose of case management and monitoring of lead-related activities.
