#### What is the Ryan White Part A Program?

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program provides HIV related services throughout the United States to those who do not have sufficient health care coverage or financial resources for coping with the disease.

#### Who is eligible for Ryan White Part A Services in the Cleveland TGA? HIV Positive people who:

- Live in the six-county region
- Meet the programs income guidelines
- Are uninsured or Underinsured

#### How do I know if I qualify for services?

To determine if you qualify for the program, contact the Ryan White Part A office. They will put you in touch with a provider who can help determine your eligibility.

# What do I have to bring with me to apply for services?

- A photo ID
- Proof of residency
- Proof of income
- Proof of HIV status
- Proof of insurance, including Medicare and Medicaid (if applicable)

### **Cleveland TGA Services**

#### **Primary Medical Care**

Provides office visits with an HIV specialist and/or nurse as well as coverage for laboratory tests.

#### **Medical Case Management**

Helps individuals access Ryan White programs and navigate the system of care.

#### Oral Health Care

Preventive dental care as well as therapeutic dental treatment for existing problems.

#### **Medical Transportation**

Assistance provided by bus, or other means to help clients get to all medical appointments.

#### **Nutrition Services**

Services including nutritional counseling, and supplements.

#### **Mental Health Services**

Mental health treatment and counseling services offered to individuals or in a group setting.

#### Food Bank and Delivered Meals

The distribution of food and other essential items to qualified persons living with HIV/AIDS.

## **Cleveland TGA Services**

#### Home Healthcare Services

Professional nursing or attendant care services provided by a licensed health care worker in a patient's home.

#### Legal Service Assistance

Qualified HIV + individuals may seek legal advice and representation in relation to client rights and benefit navigation.

#### Support Groups

Includes support groups for individuals living with HIV/AIDS.

#### Non-Medical Case Management

Helps individuals access housing and third party payer assistance.

#### Outreach and Early Intervention Services

Programs that work to serve the newly diagnosed and those that have fallen out of care with the goal of bringing them into treatment.
