Old/New Business

Vote to Finalize 2024/25 Survey – L.J. Sylvia

In prior discussion on changes needed for the next survey, we will now review the updates to make sure everything is in order before it is approved.

Survey Updates

- **1.** Demographics-This remains the same for where people receive care, where they live, and for gender.
- 2. Question #7 "What is your race?" The category (multi-race) was added, and updated in the exact way it is listed on the Reflectiveness report, so that people identifying with more than one race now have the option of selecting that category.
- <u>3. Question #9</u> "How long has it been since you were diagnosed with HIV?" This was updated so people can select one, as this will help with data collection. They were also listed in five year increments.
- N. O'Neal We should add one to let them write in the year, if more than 25 years old.
- **L.J. Sylvia** The last selection in this category will be changed to "over 25, as this will help us see who is the highest.
- <u>4. Demographics Duplicate Page</u> We will fix this before using the survey.
- **5.** Question #13 "Which of these services have you used in the past 12 months?" Per Mike's suggestion, this now reads, "The following services are funded by Ryan White Part A funds. If you want to learn more about these services, contact a social worker or go to this website: https://ccbh.net/ryan-white-services/."
- <u>6. Question #55</u> This was originally two questions, which was confusing to some, and it has now been combined into one that reads, "If you are over 55, do you have specific challenges or health concerns related to your age and HIV? If so, please describe below in detail.

F. Ross - If people are comfortable enough to ask those questions, we should be comfortable enough to answer them. They survey looks good and nothing is in survey that when we're discussing, we don't already talk about.

N. O'Neal – If all in agreement, the survey is approved.

L.J. Sylvia – We will make last adjustments, get a QI code, and go over it with chairs for final review.

- **F. Ross Will do Lorain Pride** and wherever else help is needed.
- N. O'Neal Will do Cleveland Pride, is there a table?
- B. Gayheart Part A office informed that we have a table at Lorain and will forward that info.
- Z. Levar For Cleveland Pride, our department (CCBH) gets two tables, one for 'Love Leads Here' and one for CCBH. We will have two tables for whoever wants to be part of that.
- L.J. Sylvia There will be two tables at June 1st Cleveland Pride and not only CLC but all PC members can join and participate.
- N. O'Neal Maybe spread out at multiple tables, adjust shifts to help with coverage, and do t-shirts.
- Z. Levar We could look into t-shirts. It may be difficult for this event, but something we could definitely look into for future events.
- **L.J. Sylvia** As a question was asked on what is allowable for small gifts like candy for participating, we want to be mindful of what's important to focus on at these events. We want to make it clear what this survey is, how it's different than the previous one they just filled out, and then strategize on the main goal in going out to these events, whether to get the word out, or to answer questions. We also don't want people confused about the survey, so maybe we can use a different color paper or design. With that, is the higher priority getting the survey completed?
- **N.** O'Neal They are **both level on what we need,** but with the survey it depends on how many people are attending, as the one in Lorain was more relaxed for conversation.
- L.J. Sylvia- The materials needed for the events so far include, info cards for the listening sessions and the current survey (maybe having an image to distinguish it from previous one).
- N. O'Neal Also, Metro and UH have picnics in places where PLWH come, where we could share flyers.
- L.J. Sylvia Would like to add outlying counties to this as a way of increasing relationships there.
- B. Willis We could also focus on events in 44102 (near Westside, Detroit-Shoreway area, between Ohio City and Lakewood, and 44109 (parts of Slavic Village, southeastern areas).
- C. Droster Juneteenth may be good way to reach out to the African-American community.
- L.J. Sylvia WeThink4AChange is involved in a Juneteenth event in the Buckeye-Shaker area.
- B. Gayheart Maybe we can also have a formal invite at PC meeting and at the other committees so everyone knows help is needed.
- L.J. Sylvia Do you want this done at the announcement portion of meetings?
- F. Ross Only issue is that may not give enough time for CLE Pride. Maybe we can send an email on what CLC is doing to all members. All PC should attend to answer questions even if they're not official.
- L.J. Sylvia We should reach out to partners asking if they would be willing to pass out materials. This way, even if we're not able to be present at every event, there will be people around to distribute our

materials. Also, with partnership, we can reach out to the Prevention Committee, as a way to break the silos and do more integration with Prevention on the care side, and maybe get their event lists.

N. O'Neal - For those with mobility challenges, is there accessible parking/unloading area available?

M. Baker – We will check on parking and logistics, as several have attended that event in the past.

L.J. Sylvia - Also, if we can get t-shirts, how would we do this, and is there room in the budget?

Z. Levar - Not concerned on the budget. We will first have to check with our project officer for confirmation, then go through the purchasing process, which would take time.

L.J. Sylvia – We will check with Monica and Zach on event plans, and go to PC to see who can also join.
