Community Outreach and Prevention Efforts

In 2024, Cleveland Department of Public Health (CDPH) participated in the first year of the OD2A initiative in Cleveland, OH under strategies 1A, 2A, and 3A (Linkage to Care, Harm Reduction and Stigma Reduction Efforts). From January 2024- August 2024, CDPH was able to:



159 individuals were screened for SUD



2,282 individuals attended 42 community events



36 Narcan kits were installed



5 families participated in harm reduction efforts across 12 weeks

On average, 2 individuals actively participated in the Community Reinforcement and Family Training (CRAFT) program which aims to help families impacted by Substance Use Disorder (SUD)

Harm Reduction Events



36 Narcan kits were installed equally in the zipcodes 44124 and 44128 across Cuyahoga County




99 hours were spent directly working with community members on linkage to care and harm reduction services with six individuals linked to services

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
