- Any approval issued for an STS site review is valid for five (5) years from the date of approval.
- A completed Site and Soil Evaluation must be submitted as required in OAC 3701-29.
- (2) copies of a Site Plan in accordance with OAC 3701-29-10(C) must be included for actual project approval, as well as house plans. Conditional approval may be granted for undeveloped properties and subdivisions without the submittal of a system design or house plans, but an additional Site Review must be completed incorporating the actual STS design and house plans prior to the issuance of an installation permit.
 - It is recommended that Site Plans be prepared by a professional engineer or surveyor with experience in soil absorption sewage treatment system design.
- Property lines, primary and replacement soil absorption areas and general house location must be staked and clearly identified on the lot prior to requesting a site review.
- Site review submittals must indicate if a variance is being requested. A separate variance request must be submitted prior to site review approval.
- Areas designated for the primary installation and replacement of the STS must be protected from vehicular traffic and other disturbances. It is the responsibility of the property owner to ensure the protection of these areas. Failure to protect these areas may result in forfeiture of approval granted by this department deeming the property unsuitable to support the installation of an STS.
- After receiving this application, a sanitarian will contact you to arrange a convenient time to conduct the Site Review.
 - O Please allow at least thirty (30) days for a site review to be completed once CCBH receives all documents associated and required with the application. Revisions to the design and missing items will prolong the approval process and may result in additional resubmittal fees.

FAQ: Which Site Review Project Description

- Site Review for Sewage Treatment System (Replacement System or Alteration)
 - Check this box if: You are replacing a failing Sewage Treatment System (STS), replacing a component (altering), or are building on a lot that currently has or used to have a home and STS.
- Site Review for Sewage Treatment System (Per Undeveloped Lot)
 - Check this box if: You are building on an undeveloped lot. You will need a full set of house plans, soil evaluation, and site plan for the proposed STS.
- Site Review for Sewage Treatment System Conditional Approval (Per Undeveloped Lot)
 - Check this box if: You are buying, selling, or building on an undeveloped lot. You may not have a complete STS design or house plans yet, but you must know how many bedrooms you are proposing, as well as a soil evaluation and site plans for the STS.
- System Design Plan Re-Submittal Fee
 - o Check this box if: You already submitted plans to our office for a site review, but have changed the location of the home, number of bedrooms, or have altered the initial design.
- Site Review Consultation Fee
 - Check this box if: You are considering buying, selling, or building on a lot, but are unsure how to proceed further with planning your future home and STS. You do not need to have soil work completed or a site plan, but the more information you can provide will yield more detailed recommendations. You should know how many bedrooms you are proposing. It is recommended that you speak to a Registered Sanitarian in our office prior to choosing this option.
