Recipient Report	 Zach Levar presenting: 32.5% spent and paid out to providers. We were at 19% on this date last year. The target for expenditures at this point in the year is 33.3% expended. Under vs over spending is usually evaluated after August invoices are received. There are no concerns at the moment for any category being over or under spent. Carryover awarded on 7/28 and Full award received 7/31. The total award (FY25 base award plus FY24 carryover) is \$4,844,994.00 The Part A Supervisor position should be filled in September. We attended a HRSA reverse site visit earlier this month. This was an opportunity to hear from HRSA about best practices, and provide our feedback to them. MATEC provided a trauma-informed care training for our providers on June 27th
Medicaid Update	 Christy Nicholls presenting: We are current on our non-long term care applications. This means there will be more timely responses to folks.
Part B Update	 Karla Ruiz presenting: We have a new Part B Administrator, Stacy Herman, who started on June 30th. We met with Zach from CCBH and with MetroHealth and NLURC today. We had our Part B HRSA site visit this past July.
HOPWA Update	Tiffany Greene presenting: • We are waiting for funds from HUD.
Planning Council Business	 a. Changes to Medicaid and SNAP – Christy Nicholls We are waiting on the rules to be written by FNS for SNAP and CMS for Medicaid. About 98,000 people in Cuyahoga County fall into Group 8. State trigger language means that if the federal FMAP is decreased for Group 8, then Ohio will no longer provide Group 8 coverage Changes to SNAP – expanded work requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents. Repeals exemptions for veterans, homeless individuals, and former foster youth. Funding changes to SNAP – share of administrative cost increases the state share from 50% to 75%. Estimated cost to Ohio is \$60 million. There is a community forum on 9/8 at 5pm to cover the changes to Medicaid and SNAP. b. Site Visit Follow Up – Corrective Action Plan - Lj Our site visit was in March. The Planning Council has 5 findings that need to be corrected,
	 including: Membership issues, updating the bylaws, implementing a new process for the Planning Council budget, and creating a separate Policies and Procedures document. Executive Chairs and Executive Committee created an improvement plan and submitted it to HRSA, received feedback from HRSA, and resubmitted the plan to HRSA. C. Update on Bylaws Review - Lj MRM and Executive Committees are currently reviewing the bylaws. Some changes have to happen to the bylaws by the end of this calendar year.
