a. CRC 2026-016 Nursing and Clinical Services submitting an addendum with Kelly Stake, MSN, APRN (Board 2024-156 & CRC 2025-230), under the 2025/2026 Reproductive Health and Wellness grant from January 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026 to increase the amount to paid from \$94,200.00 to \$104,500.00.

Purpose: To serve as PRN Nurse Practitioner for the CCBH Family Planning Clinic as needed.

Funding source: 100% reimbursable through the Reproductive Health and Wellness grant.

b. CRC 2026-017 Nursing and Clinical Services submitting a contract with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2031 for the CCBH clinic to be a Breast and Cervical Cancer Project (BCCP) approved provider. Amount to be received is based on the ODH reimbursement schedule.

Purpose: To allow CCBH to be reimbursed for BCCP client services provided through the CCBH Family Planning Clinics needed.

Funding source: Ohio Department of Health.

c. CRC 2026-018 Population Health Services submitting a contract with Cleveland Department of Public Health under the 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grant from September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026. Amount to be paid not to exceed \$25,600.00.

Purpose: To use data to drive action steps that reduce overdose morbidity and mortality in communities quickly, while addressing health disparities, with a primary focus on opioid, stimulant, and polysubstance use involving opioid and/or stimulants.

Funding source: 100% reimbursable through the 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grant.

d. CRC 2026-019 Population Health Services submitting an addendum to the contract with The Woodrow Project (Resolutions 2025-110) under the 2023/2024 and 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grants from September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026 to increase the amount to be paid from \$178,728.00 to \$182,832.00.

Purpose: To support increased effort on the program.

Funding source: 100% reimbursable through the 2023/2024 and 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grants.
