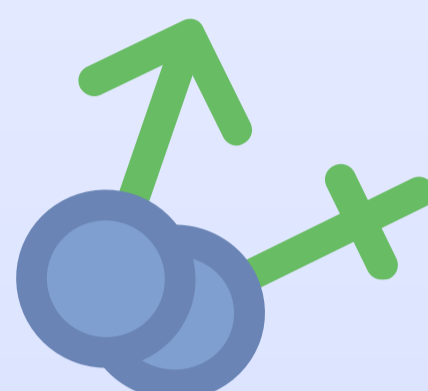

HUMADAOP supports the Hispanic community by connecting, reengaging and providing ongoing support for individuals with SUD to access treatment. All services, including overdose prevention and stigma reduction resources, peer support, and education/training are delivered in a culturally and linguistically competent manner.

Y1 & Y2 Follow up



- 75 clients followed up at 30-Day
- 12 clients followed up at 6-months
- Among reached, 15% at 30-Day and 18% at 6-months reported being engaged in treatment

86% reported criminal history

Trauma



31% reported history of trauma

Mental Health



71% reported a mental health condition

18% clients reported at least one previous overdose.

9 Community events for overdose prevention with 382 individuals attending

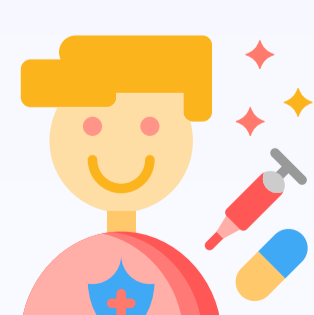
14 stigma reduction seminars held with 121 individuals trained



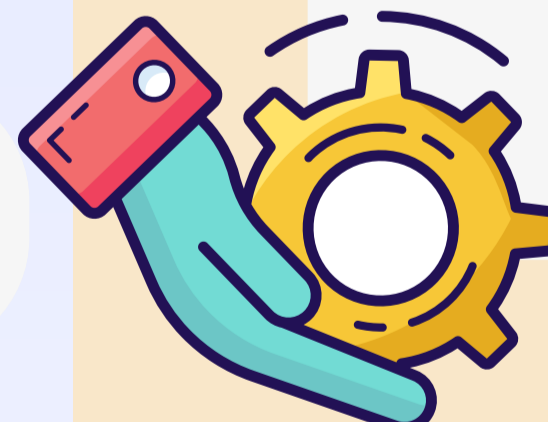
166 individuals trained on naloxone use in Spanish
