CRC 2026-066 Population Health Services submitting an addendum to the contract with Case Western Reserve University (Resolutions 2025-131) under the 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grants from September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026 to increase the amount to be paid from \$479,650.00 to \$484,172.71.

Purpose: Support data collection, database management, and analysis to inform CCBH and partners on Cuyahoga County's progress in reducing fatal and non-fatal overdoses within the County.

Funding source: 100% reimbursable through the 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 Overdose Data to Action grants.

- b. CRC 2026-067 Population Health Services submitting an addendum to the contract with Neighborhood Leadership Institute (Resolution 2025-084) under the 2025/2027 Maternal and Infant Vitality Initiative (MIVI) grant from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 to increase the amount to be paid from \$250,000.00 to \$255,000.00.

Purpose: To coordinate Neighborhood Navigation services for identified women and ensure referrals to needed resources, with 80% of participants being Black/African American and 85% reached through non-traditional outreach.

Funding source: 100% reimbursable through the 2025/2027 Maternal and Infant Vitality Initiative (MIVI) grant.
